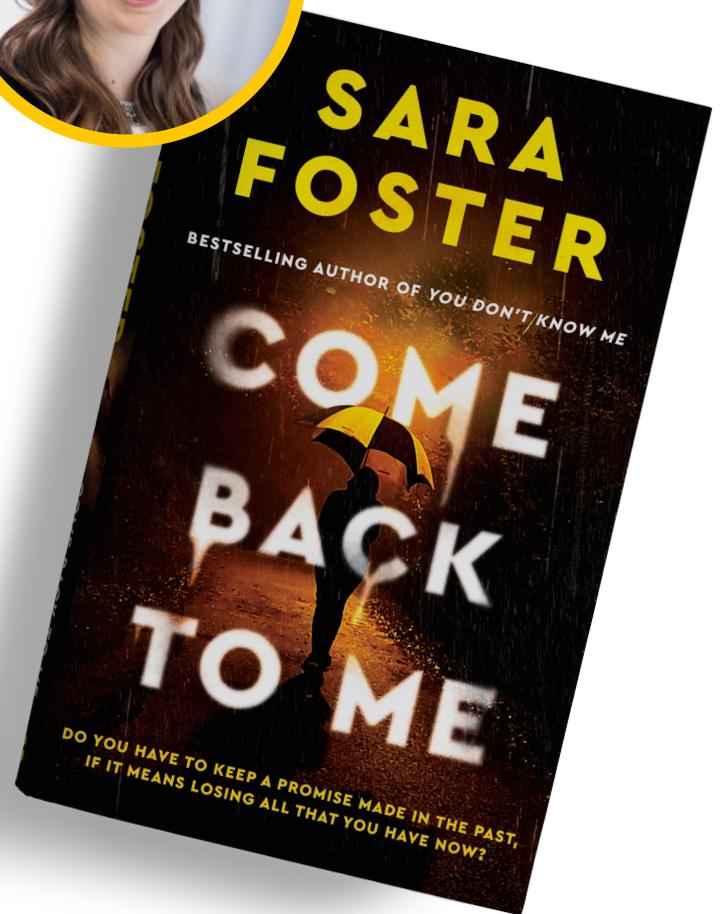


COME BACK TO ME

BOOK CLUB QUESTIONS

1. What do you think of Alex's dilemma and choices? Why do you think he chose not to tell Chloe about his past? Did you feel sympathetic or frustrated by his decisions?
2. The evolving nature of relationships between parents and children features prominently in the book. How do you feel about Chloe's relationship with her mother?
3. Did you like the way the story ended? What do you imagine the future might be like for these characters?
4. Explore the different ways that the title theme of *Come Back to Me* resonates throughout the book.
5. The way different people deal with loss is a theme of the novel. Which loss stands out for you and why?
6. Mark is a complex character. How do you feel about him and his choices in the story?
7. Throughout the novel, there are lots of references to opportunities for connection between the characters, opportunities that might not happen again, or moments when they have to choose

whether to speak or to withhold information. Can you identify some of these? What do you think of the choices each character makes?

8. Writing about traumatic events isn't easy. How did you feel about the way the author handled the traumatic parts of the story?
9. Each character goes on some kind of figurative journey within the novel. By the end, what do you think they each have learned, and how might it change them?
10. Was the ending the one you wanted, or would you have preferred it if the story ended differently? And how did you feel about the reveal at the end of the book?
